MARKETS and FINANCE

Toronto: Markets continue forward; industrials register narrow gains.

New York: Market higher; quiet recovery continues.
Montreal: Majority of sections unchanged; industrials higher.

Montreal Stocks
MONTREAL (CP)—Industrials leaned forward at the close of dull trading on the stock market Friday.

Walker gained 3 points to 78, Industrial Acceptance, 1 1/2 to 56 1/2 and Bank of Commerce, 1 1/2 to 45 1/2.

In a 60-share movement, International Power lost 3 points to 185, Toronto Dominion Bank at 47 and International Utilities at 39, each fell a point.

Base metals and papers showed marked improvement. Other sections were slightly higher.

Mines fluctuated in moderately active dealings. Bright spots included Consolidated Sudbury, up 5 cents at \$5.20, Steep Rock, up 1/2 at 1 1/2, Normetal, up 30 cents at \$2.92.

The stock exchanges closing averages show banks up 0.03 at 50.48, utilities up 0.4 at 137.3, industrials up 1.1 at 288.8, combined up 0.9 at 238.3, papers up 2.39 at 1388.74 and golds up 0.53 at 81.30.
