

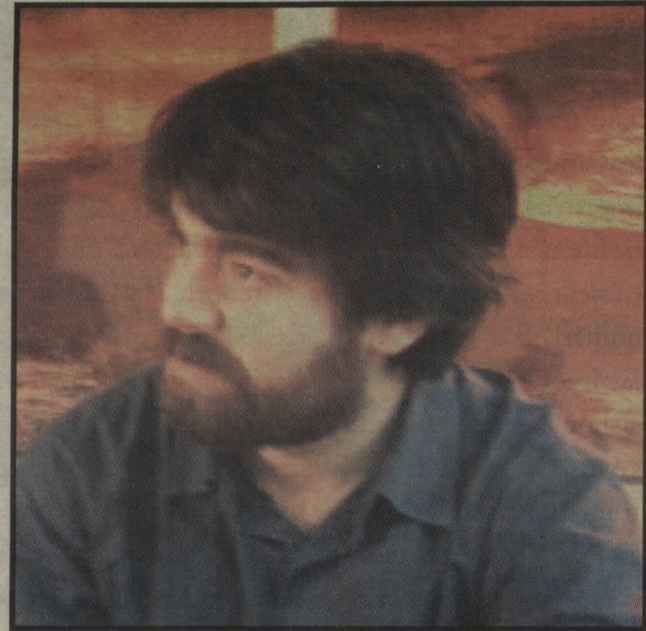
What does academic integrity mean to you?
