ern part of the country is still the largest producing area in India after almost forty centuries of cultivation. Other localities, he said, were no so fortunate, and the proposed plans for new irrigation schemes, plus the growing of leguminous crops, are hoped to provide better fertility in the future. The present financial situation prevents the use of imported chemical fertilizers, Dr. Joshi said.

### Co-operation Stressed

The only method whereby the greatest good can be accomplished for the greatest number is by the co-operative system, stated Mr. Hamid, and the smallness of the average holding in India, plus the relatively large percentage of the population engaged in agriculture, places the individual out of reach of a department. By working through organizations such as the co-operatives, and the farmers using the benefits of bulk buying of seed and equipment, and the individual farmer is now using better methods and obtaining increased yields. The co-operative system has been in operation in India since 1905. Mr. Hamid said and in contrast to the predominantly marketing co-operative system used in Canada, the Indian system is multi-purpose.

Mr. G.M. Butt spoke of the climate and the resources of Kashmir, and the various experiments which have been carried out to increase the production of rice and other grains in the testing of imported seed and in many instances this has proved very successful. Numerous varieties of vegetables are now being grown, and Kashmir is now exporting large amounts of fruit. He also stated that the whole of the forest lands of his country is cropped, with selective cutting and replanting of cut areas.

Mr. W.R. Shaw, Deputy Minister of Agriculture, thanked the speakers, and said that while they may have learned much during their visit to this country, we also could learn a good deal from them.

### Eastern Five In Show At Montague

Residents of Montague were treated to a very fine show last evening at Yeo's Theatre when Nova Scotia's Eastern Five from Sydney, featuring the Bourgeault family, presented an excellent evening's entertainment of songs, tap dancing, comedy and music. The two-hour programme was enthusiastically applauded by the large audience which attended the performance, which indicated the musical and acting ability of the players. Mr. Bourgeault, or "Eddie" is well known throughout the Island, having been a former member of Don Messer's troupe, and this was not his first appearance in Montague, having been here on several occasions with Messer's Islanders. Their tour of the Island will take them to Charlottetown and Summerside after which they will leave for Newfoundland where they are engaged for several months.
