N.Y. Stock Market Price Trend On Upgrade Last Week

NEW YORK, (AP)—The stock market extended its recovery from the February reaction lows last week. Gains were extensive and volume was high. All in all, the market acted as though it wished to leave the traditionally bearish February and get a running start on the usually bullish month of March.

Buying enthusiasm can be traced to two main factors—lower margins and price decontrol orders. Heavy volume was the thing that encouraged the bulls. It averaged 2,242,000 shares a day. That's the best daily average in more than two years.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks closed the week at \$114.20 with a gain of \$1.40, the best showing since the final week of January.

Can this boom continue? The average professional in Wall Street doesn't think it can for long; the experts look for further readjustment in the market through mid-March, and then they anticipate an upturn. They are guessing on past performances.

The five most active issues this week were Pepsi-Cola up 1 1/2 to 7-8 with 188,900 shares traded, Willys-Overland up 1 3/8 at 14 1/8, Pan American World Airways up 1-2 at 11 1/2, Avco Mfg. up 5-8 at 8 5/8, and Baldwin-Lima-Hamilton up 5-8 at 11 1/8.

Canadian stocks were higher Friday, Canadian Pacific and International Nickel both added 1-4. Dome Mines gained 1-4 to 23 3/8 and McIntyre advanced 1 3/4 to 68 3/4. Distillers Seagram dropped 1-8 and Hiram Walker fell 1-2.

Royalite Oil fell 1-4 on the American stock exchange. Giant Yellowknife was ahead 1-8 and Lake Shore was up 1-2.

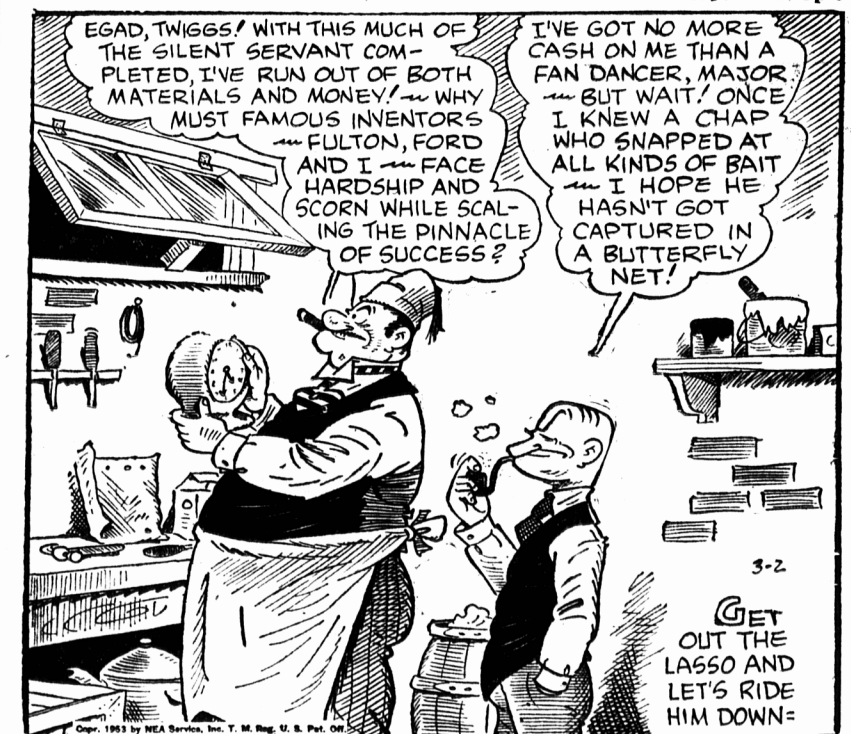

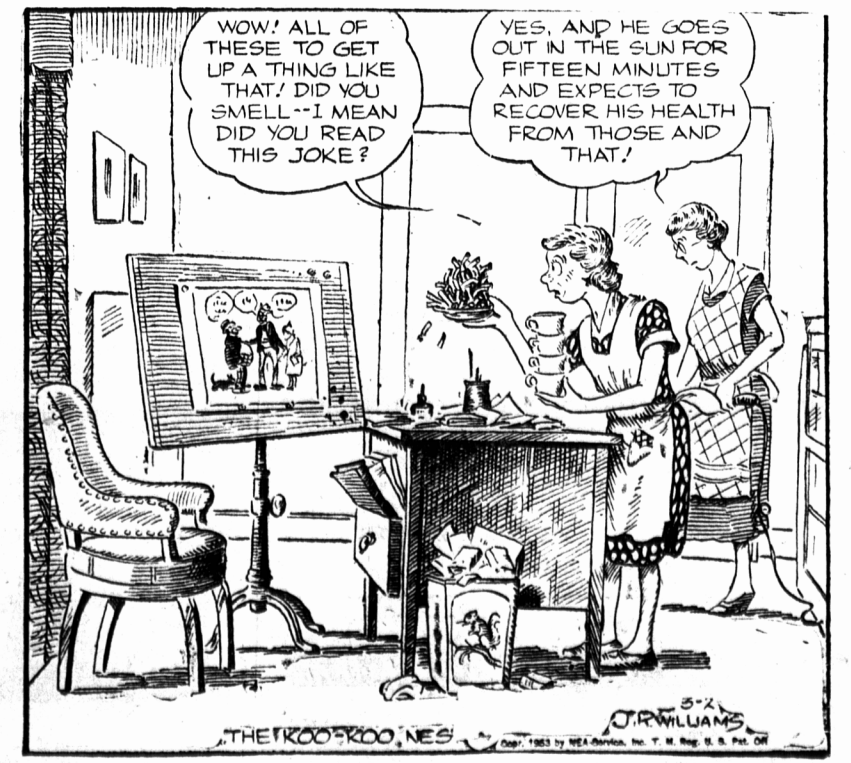

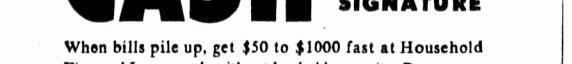
