## Prince County Resident Has Interesting Hobby

If you are travelling in western Prince County this summer you might pay a visit to Carl Profitt at Alma Corner. Mr. Profitt is a paraplegic who can only get around by means of a wheelchair. He is not quite helpless, however. He runs a service station at the Corner. And he has a very interesting hobby.

After a long illness Mr. Profitt began his hobby in the fall of 1965. He has designed various candy dishes, night and TV lights, book ends, group baskets, center pieces, grave markers and various kinds of tile board entirely out of scallop shells.

In an interview recently Mr. Profitt stated that he had recently completed a grave marker which he felt was one of his most important pieces of work. Enclosed in the scallop shell dome is plastic flowers with a light at the back. "These everlasting lights are constructed to withstand wind and rain," Mr. Profitt added.

Another important item designed by Mr. Profitt is the scallop shell tile board. Mr. Profitt remarked that this tile board

can be used to beautify building fronts and is also attractive when lit up at night.

### SUSTAINS FRACTURE

Mr. Profitt became a paraplegic in September 1960 as a result of an accident at a Tignish service station. A wall of the building collapsed and Mr. Profitt in trying to save the lives of the men working under him sustained a multiple fracture in his spine and a fracture in the right leg below the knee.

After a long period of convalescence he gradually improved to the stage where he was able to get around in a wheelchair.

After receiving help from the Workmen's Compensation Board, Texaco Company of Canada and the Bank of Commerce in Alberton in 1963 he designed a modern service station and is now running it with the able assistance of his wife and six children. He is married to the former Jannie Harper of Tignish and they have 12 children, six of which are living at home.

## Jury Attributes Death To Four-Car Accident

GEORGETOWN — An inquest into the death of Francis Cornelius MacCormack of Georgetown was held here last night. Mr. MacCormack, the verdict brought in by the jury said, came to his death at approximately 7:30 p.m. October 31, 1965 on the Seven Mile Road between Cardigan and Bridgetown from multiple internal injuries sustained in an accident involving four automobiles. Corner Dr. G. S. A. Inman presided.

Mr. MacCormack, 65, was a passenger in a car driven by his brother, Daniel. There were two other passengers in the car at the time of the accident.

In was reported last night that the MacCormack vehicle was proceeding east on Seven Mile Road when it ran into the rear of a parked car owned by Joseph Wallace MacDonald, Primrose.

The impact of the collision drove the MacDonald car forward striking a car driven by Lemuel Butler of Alliston. The MacCormack car careened off the MacDonald vehicle and came to rest sideways on the left side of the road, blocking part of the road.

A car owned by Anita Somers and driven by William Connon approached the scene travelling westward into the MacCormack car.
