New York Stocks

NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market dipped into another of its mild corrections last week. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks fell \$8.10 in the first four days of the week and on the final day gained 40 cents. A week ago the average stood at a 25-year high mark.

It was just about a year ago that the market started its long climb. No setback during that time has been severe. The last week was about like the others: An average fall of less than 10 per cent of the last year's advance.

The sharpest fall of the week came Monday during the troubles over the European Defence Community. The decline continued Tuesday as the Brazilians faced their internal troubles.

The fall Wednesday was marked with intense selling that at one time swamped the ticker in reporting actual floor transactions. Thursday found the selloff continuing, but there was good recovery late in the day.

Friday's market was a quiet affair and prices edged up on low volume.

Canadian stocks gave a mixed appearance at the week's end. Advancing were International Nickel, up 1/2, and Distillers Seagram, ahead 1/4. Lower were Dome Mines and Canadian Pacific, down 1/4 and 1/2 respectively.

Lower Canadian issues on the American stock exchange included Lake Shore, Giant Yellowknife and Royalite Oil, each down 1/2.

U. S. Steel

CLEVELAND (AP)—It is significant, says Steel magazine, that warehouse business is picking up, and that means an important turn in the steel market.

"That's significant because of the diversity of consumers who get their steel from warehouses," the weekly trade journal reported. "As a whole, warehouse customers are the smaller users of steel, but because there are a great many of them they form a market for approximately 20 per cent of all finished steel sold."

Some warehouses had August business 20 to 25 per cent better than in July. Although July was "a very poor month," says Steel, the August business still was 10 per cent better than in the more "normal" months of May and June.

"Improvement is probable due to three things," it continued: "Steel inventories have been pretty well liquidated. Most consuming plants are back to work after a v.a.
