On Sunday, Nov. 7, the UPEI basketball Panthers entertained St. F.X. in a non-conference game. The X-Men squeaked out a 104-101 victory in overtime.

The Panthers led through out the contest, being up by as much as 13 points with less than ten minutes remaining, but the X-men got hot and whittled away at the lead until they edged ahead 96-94 with only seconds remaining. The Panthers scrambled for a shot frantically, and scored on Mike Connolly's 25 foot jumper as the crowd exploded into frenzy. The Panthers pulled ahead at the beginning of the overtime period, and then tried to hang on. Midway through the period, tempers flared in front of the UPEI bench, and Brian O'Shaughnessy was ejected from the game. This could have been the turning point of the contest, as the Big O had played an excellent game up to this point, and had been instrumental in the teams early success. The X-Men pulled ahead by 102-101, and the Panthers went down to defeat as Connolly's last ditch shot rolled out at the buzzer.

The Panthers put together one of their better efforts of the last two years. Fouls hurt the team quite a bit. However, X had a definite height advantage, and the Panther squad more than held their own. Things appear bright on the basketball scene this year, and the Panthers could be one of the powerful squads in the league. This week they travel to Memorial University to do battle with the Beothuks.
