

# Food Charges On Stalled Train Spark Complaints By Passengers

**VANCOUVER (CP)**—A total of 150 passengers who were stranded for 17 hours by snow slides in the Fraser Canyon arrived in Vancouver Friday with a barrage of complaints.

The Canadian Pacific Railway train, The Canadian, was 24 hours late on the trip from Montreal when it arrived at Union Station.

The Canadian was halted at North Bend, B.C., 136 miles east of Vancouver, from mid-morning Thursday until early Friday.

The CPR lines are across the Fraser Canyon from the CNR rails where the CNR's Panorama train has been trapped since Wednesday.

Some passengers complained there was no food for those whose all-inclusive tickets ran out and who had no money to purchase meals.

The squeeze is usually easy to execute and easy to understand. However, some squeeze situations are complicated and difficult to grasp even when they are closely examined.

Here is a rare kind of squeeze which you may never have encountered. It is reported by Enrique de Menses, of Spain, in Bridge Writer's Choice 1964.

South won the heart lead with the queen, cashed four diamonds, and continued with the A-K of hearts and A-K of spades. Having won nine tricks

South knew from the previous play that West now had one heart, one diamond and two clubs; he likewise knew that East had two spades and two clubs. What South did not know was whether East or West had the king of clubs.

Spurning the possibility of a club finesse, South cashed the ace at this point. This unusual play guaranteed the contract regardless of which opponent had the king.

He then led the jack of spades and West found himself in difficulty. Regardless of what he discarded, he was bound to sacrifice a critical trick. South could win the spade in either his own hand or in dummy, depending upon which suit West discarded.

South would have been equally successful if it had turned out that East had the king of clubs. In that case South would have kept the lead after West discarded his useless club, and then played a spade to force East to return a spade to the queen.

## Guilty Pleas Entered In Lottery Case

MONTREAL (CP)—Two persons arrested in a recent major seizure of Irish Sweepstakes tickets pleaded guilty and were fined Friday on lottery charges.

Mrs. Francis Kelly, 57, was fined \$15,000 and Anthony Sullivan, 34, her son-in-law, \$20,000 on a charge of selling or offering to sell lottery tickets.

Mrs. Kelly was given the option of a 15-month jail sentence and Sullivan the option of an 18-month term.

Both were allowed 30 days to pay the fines.

They were arrested Dec. 20 following police raids in suburban Dollard-des-Ormeaux and Ville LaSalle in which 5,000,000 Irish Sweepstakes with a face value of \$17,000,000 were seized.

About \$100,000 in cash and cheques were also seized.
