GRAIN

WINNIPEG, Sept. 4 - (CP) - Substantial export business in barley again highlighted trade today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. It was estimated that 2,000,000 bushels of Canadian barley had been worked for export overseas, including five cargoes to Germany and one to the Netherlands. Trade reports also said Portugal took 3,000 tons - about 158,000 bushels - of Canadian barley in the last day or two. This large export business was reflected by good export and shipper buying in barley. Domestic shippers also made purchases in oats and barley. Offerings were about in line with demand and barley prices held firm. Oats were slightly lower. Flax uncovered buying by sea-board and industrial interests. Prices here advanced. Rye dropped lower. Factors in the trade were reports of unfavorable harvest weather and indications of further rains. No information was available on export wheat loadings. Prices for class two wheat were up 1 1/2 cents. I. W. A. were up one eighth. Closing prices: Oats: Oct. 83 1/2; Dec. 81 1/2; May 83 1/4. Barley: Oct. 1.32 1/2; Dec. 1.25 1/2; May 1.24 1/4.
