(DB) with **Arctic Terns**; **Black Tern** - 1 at Malpeque in Nov. (DB); **Mourning Dove** - 40 in East Royalty daily in early Nov. (C&MW), 40 at Summerside on Dec. 6 (SE), 1 in Parkdale/Sherwood on Dec. 7 and 13 (BB); **Great-horned Owl** - 1 coming to the sound of a scare pistol at Mooney's Pond (RR, TD); **Short-eared Owl** - 1 at Dalvay on Oct. 30 (MR); **Snowy Owl** - 1 in Pictou Island area on Nov. (CS), 1 at Grant's Bridge on Morell River (MH); **Gray Jay** - 1 all summer at Monticello (GM), 2 at Grand Tracadie on Oct. 10 (MR), 2 at Monticello on Oct. 28 (GM), 1 at Dromore on Nov. 13 (JDM, BB, LY); **Red-breasted Nuthatch** - the forests have been alive this autumn with very large numbers of these nuthatches, sometimes 6 or more in a single tree (JDM, RC, DW, LH), 1 at Battery Point feeder taking sunflower seed on Oct. 26 (WP); **Bohemian Waxwing** - groups of 80 at Stanhope and Cabot Park on Nov. 29 (BlM), this fall in Summerside area (LH), 60 to 75 in Sherwood on Dec. 7 (BB), 200 feeding on ground and in bushes in Sherwood in early Dec. (BH); **Cedar Waxwing** - eating berries in Charlottetown Jul. to Sept. (EC); **Northern Shrike** - 1 attacking birds at Argyle Shore feeder (BC), 1 at Tracadie Harbour on Dec. 18 (JDM, BB); **Pine Warbler** - 1 at Indian River Reserve on Sept. 6 (LH); **Palm Warbler** - 2 at Cavendish on Oct. 7 & 8 (DW); **Eastern Meadowlark** - 1 at Monticello on Oct. (GM), 1 at Shipyard Point on Nov. 11 (JDM, BB); **Red-winged Blackbird** - about 100 at Mt. Albion on Nov. 12 (JDM); **Northern Oriole** - 2 males in East Royalty on May 28 (EC), 1 heard in Sherwood on Jul. 1 (EC), 1 in Sherwood hedge and visiting feeder from Dec. 7 to 13 (BH); **Common Grackle** - 3 at West Point on Dec. 7 (ME via HM), 1 at Upton feeder last winter and this winter (RRI); **Northern Cardinal** - female in Charlottetown in Sept. (JD); 1 male on Oct. 20th at feeder and both male and female on Oct. 22 the one or both seen to the 25th (EH via WP), 1 at New Annan on Oct. 27 (BM), male and female near Hunter River about Nov. 1 (FL), 1 female at feeder in West Royalty on Nov. 10 (DL), 2 at Rustico feeder on Nov. 14 (N&EM via EM), 1 female at Southwest Lot 16 on Dec. 2 & 3 (MCM via VMacN), 1 female at Summerside on Dec. 6 (SE), 1 in West Point on Dec. 7 for last 2 weeks (ME through HM), 1 in Mount Stewart Dec. 1 - 7 (BPi), 1 at Montague from mid-Nov. to mid-Dec.
