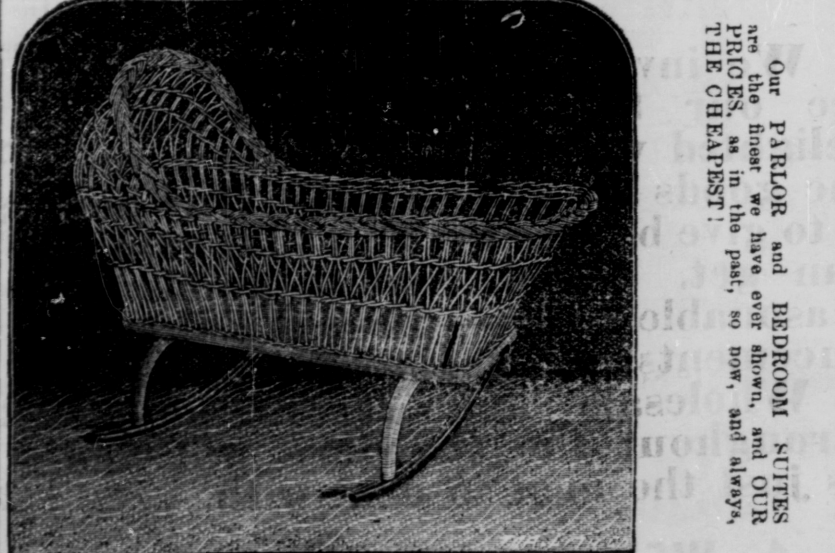

Provincial Legislature House of Assembly

EVENING SESSION—(Continued.)

Mr. Shaw, in opening, censured the Leader of the Government for his sneering and uncalled for remarks in reference to the capacity and ability of some of the speakers who had preceded him. He then took up the so-called "suggestions" made to the Act respecting the Legislature by the Legislative Council, and spoke of them in the manner in which they had been dealt with by the House. He considered that the suggestions were, properly speaking, amendments, and should have been considered with open doors. This was the contention of the Opposition. The Speaker of the House, he said, for the past two years, we are told, had accepted the ruling of the Speaker, and by a majority vote decided to sit with closed doors—that the press representatives and a very much interested public should remain without while they were robbing a goodly portion of the people of a heaven-born privilege. They did not want the people to witness their evil work—they were ashamed of what they were doing. The manner in which King's County was cut out and carved to suit the purposes of the Government was simply disgraceful. King's County had stood nobly by the Conservative Party in the past, and it was for so doing that her people were being so vilely treated now. While the amendments were ostensibly submitted by the Legislative Council, they plainly bore the imprint of the despot who had ruled over this Province for the past two years. We are told that the new district of Georgetown—the "Springgourized" district—was to be provided with steam communication, that \$500 was to be appropriated for that purpose. But what does this mean? It means simply that \$100 has been added to the subsidy paid the Eldon, which formerly did this work—which steamer has been merged into a new company. The late Government was censured by the Opposition of their day for not making revenue and expenditure meet. The Opposition said that if they had the reins they would be able to do it. But now that they are in power what are they doing? Are they keeping their promises? Let us see. For 1891 the estimated revenue was \$268,919.86, and the estimated expenditure \$270,906—a deficit of \$1,986.14. The actual revenue for 1891 was \$247,421, and the actual expenditure \$304,456.41—an actual deficit of \$30,339.20. The estimated receipts from the Land Office last year were \$90,000, the actual receipts were \$72,878.43. The receipts were therefore \$17,121.57 less than the amount estimated. Had the receipts from this source been only equal to the amount estimated the actual deficit for 1891 would have been \$43,217.63 instead of \$30,339.20. If the expenditure for 1892 is equal to that of 1891 and the revenue will be the same, the deficit at the end of the year will not be less than \$89,000. The estimated revenue for 1892 is \$263,444, and the expenditure \$267,444—an estimated deficit of \$4,000. How can they expect to carry on the affairs of the Province this year on \$267,444? Have they made any effort to make revenue and expenditure meet? While we were making deficits we were pressing our claims upon the Dominion and adding to our capital at Ottawa. But what is the present Government doing? Are they pressing our claims? We asked for correspondence in reference to this matter, but none was brought down. He did not think there was any to table. He believed the Government was sleeping on our rights. They would not have got the amount they did for public lands had they not violated the law by making greater reductions than were allowable under the statute. But the Government's estimates for the year 1892 are largely imaginary. To illustrate: Last year the administration of justice cost the Province \$13,972.13; this year the amount set down for that purpose is \$15,487. The difference is \$1,514.87. What is there to justify the Government in putting a smaller sum in the estimates for that purpose this year than they did last year? Will there be less crime than there was last year? The estimate for education last year was \$108,000, the expenditure totalled up \$113,022.98. The expenditure over the estimates was \$5,022.98. The estimate for education for 1892 is \$111,510. How can we expect that the expenditure will be less than this year? The estimate for that purpose is \$115,487. The difference is \$3,977. The estimate for education is one that cannot be controlled. We told the Government last year that the sum they set apart was not sufficient, and our prediction was verified. Then last year their estimate for wharves and ferry slips was \$500,000. The Government claimed that this amount would be enough, although our Government had entered into contracts amounting to more than that sum. What was the result? They spent \$17,389.83—only \$12,389.83 more than they estimated. This year they estimate that \$30,000 will be sufficient. Let year, out of the total expenditure of \$17,983.29, only \$1,557 were spent for wharves and ferry slips contracted for by the late Government. The expenditure last year on roads was \$19,681.89. The estimate was \$15,000. The difference between the amount estimated and the amount expended was \$4,681.89. The estimate for this year is \$15,000. And they used to tell us that if they were in power they would give twice as much for this purpose as we gave! Then there is the amount of \$2,000 for stock for the Stock Farm and superintendency. But what about them for the experimental silo and travelling dairy? Are we going to get these things for nothing? Then after censuring the Commissioner of Public Works for not bringing down certain information asked for, he turned his attention to the Land Office. He pointed out that although the late Government had arranged to have the report of the Land Office investigation published in the Journals of the House as part of the history of the Province, the present Administration, for reasons not far to seek, did not do so. No greater proof of Mr. Ferguson's clean hands could be adduced
