N. Y. Stock Market Gets Shot In Arm

NEW YORK, (AP)—The stock market got its long-hoped-for shot in the arm Friday when margin requirements were cut by the federal reserve board.

The reduction in the required down payment on securities to 50 per cent from 75 per cent was a goal long sought.

It was too late to affect trading in last week, when volume, touched the lowest daily average since the final week in October.

The week's lull was seen as added evidence of the need for a potent stimulant such as brokers hope will result from the lowered margin requirements.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks closed the week unchanged at \$112.80, the same as the week before.

Volume for the week simmered down to the lowest daily average of the year at 1,326,000 shares.

The five most active issues last week on the New York stock exchange were:

Pepsi-Cola up 1 1/8 at 12 7/8 with 126,000 shares traded. Pan American World Airways up 3/8 at 11, New Haven Railroad up 4 5/8 at 32 7/8, Packard Motor Car up 1/4 at 6 1/4, and American Telephone off 1/8 at 159 3/8.

Canadian issues were higher Friday. Canadian Pacific, International Nickel and Distillers Seagram each gained 3/8. Hiram Walker was ahead 7/8, McIntyre slipped 1/4 and Dome Mines was not quoted.

On the American stock exchange, Royalite Oil added 1/4. Giant Yellowknife dropped 1/8 and Lake Shore was not quoted.

U. S. Steel Report

CLEVELAND, (AP)—Recent easing of government controls on steel will have little effect on consumer supplies during the first half of this year, Steel Magazine says today.

An "open end" order on the controlled materials plan was put into effect Feb. 13. This allows steel above the amount needed to fill allotments to be sold without restriction.

"But there likely will be little of this excess steel in the finished forms that are in strongest demand, for there are enough CMP tickets in circulation to sop up all of the hard-to-get items," Steel reports.

The weekly summary of the metalworking industry says "free" steel will cover only those products which already are plentiful.

Plans New Models Of Automobiles

TORONTO, (CP)—The Standard Motor Company of Coventry plans a low-priced sports car for North American markets and a small "economy" car for European markets.

Sir John Black, the company's deputy-chairman and managing director, said Saturday that the sports car is designed along the lines of the Jaguar sports model but will sell for about \$2,200. He said he expects the car will be available in Canada this year.

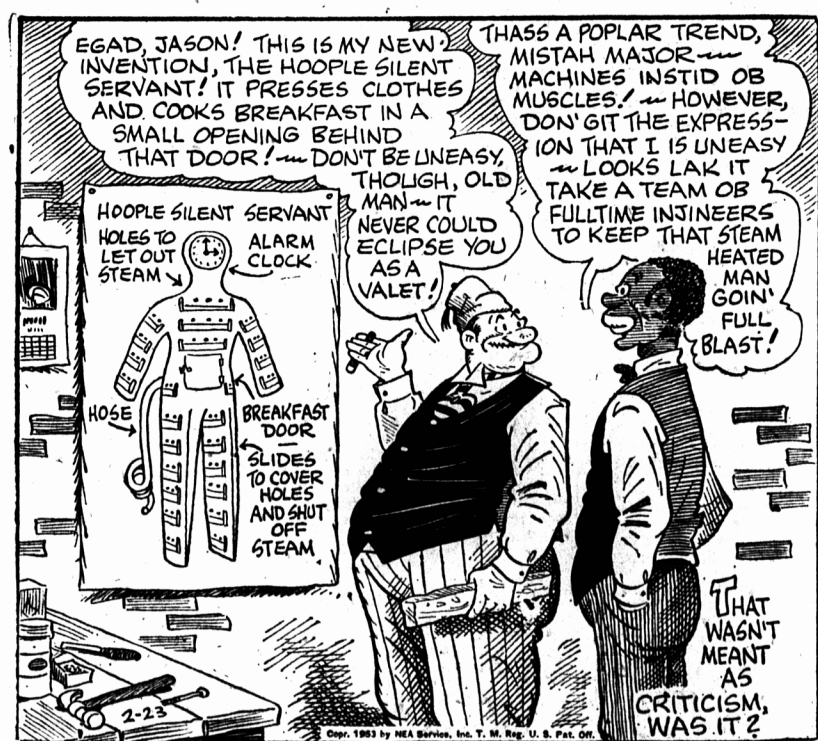
