Union.

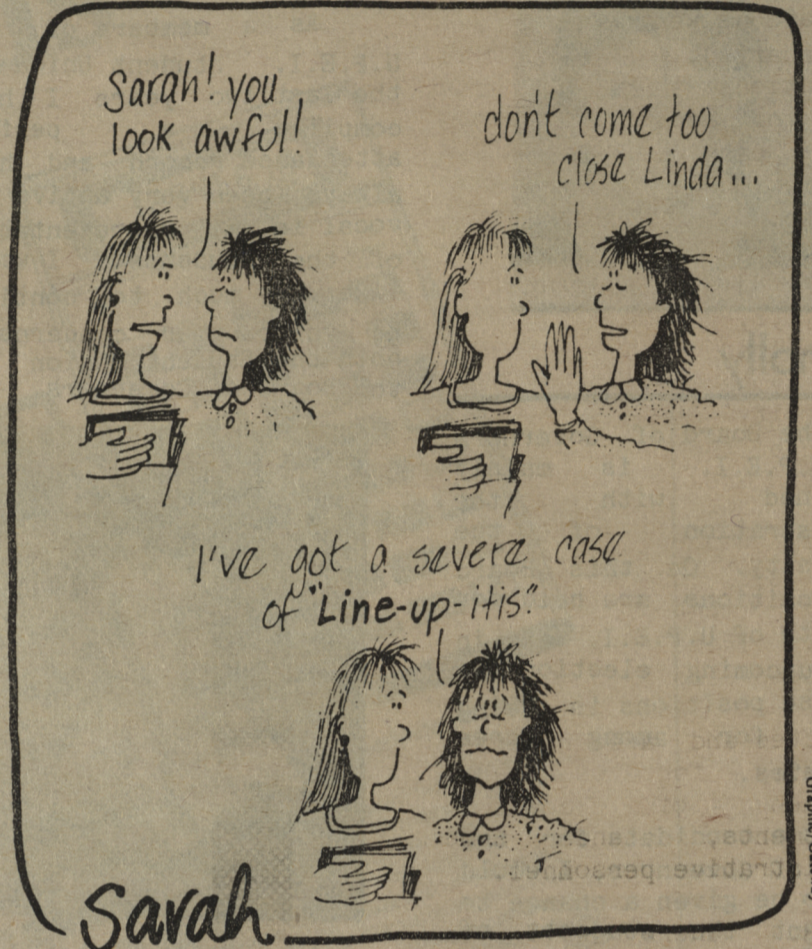
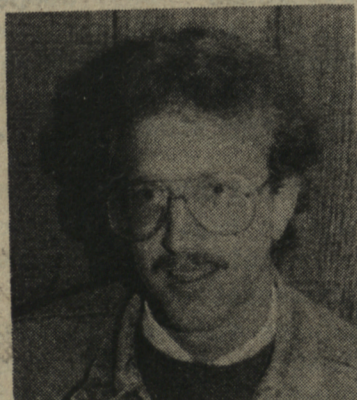


In conclusion, whether
