sand, and surf.

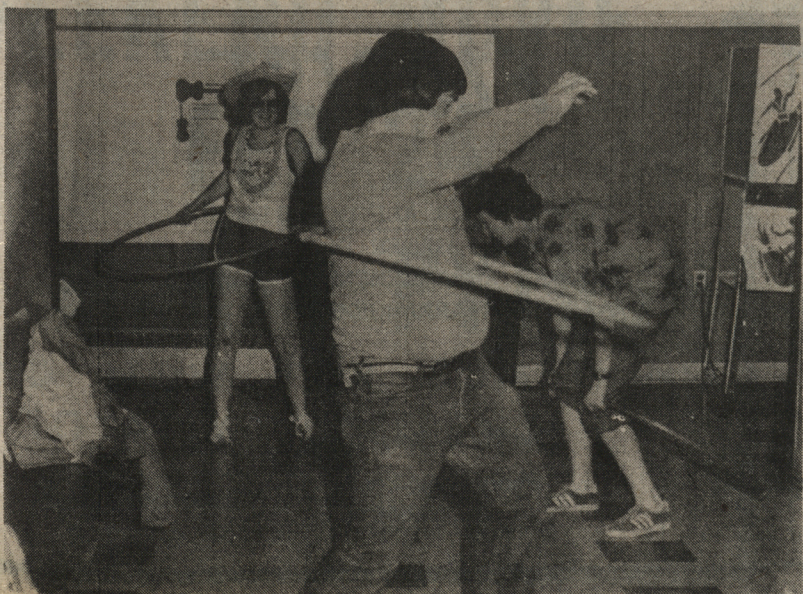
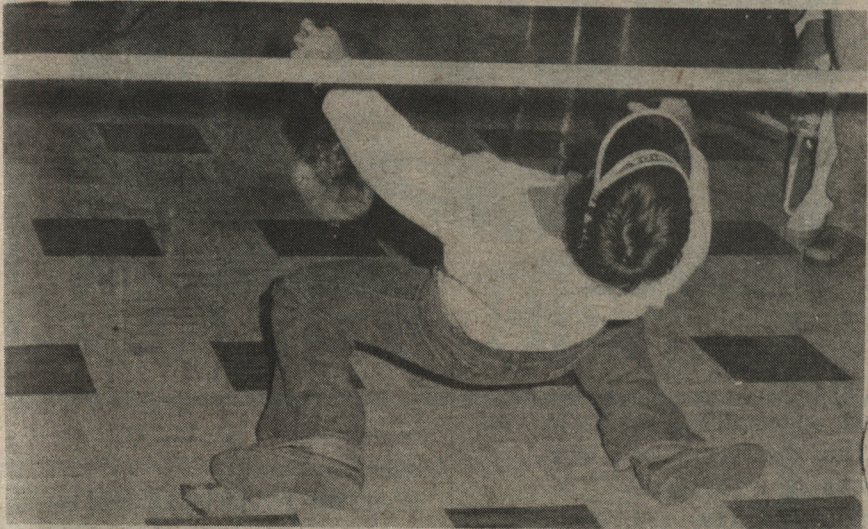
Limbo and hula hoop
