

IN MEMORIAM

JOHN E. NEILL

In the passing of John Robert Neill on September 15th, 1951, in the P. E. Island Hospital, the Baptist Church of Fairview, North Milton, lost one of its most loyal members and the community an outstanding resident.

Born in North Milton, seventy-six years ago, a son of the late Wm. Neill, his wife the former Margaret A. Horne, he devoted his time to his home, his church and community.

For many years he served as Deacon, also Superintendent of the Sunday School.

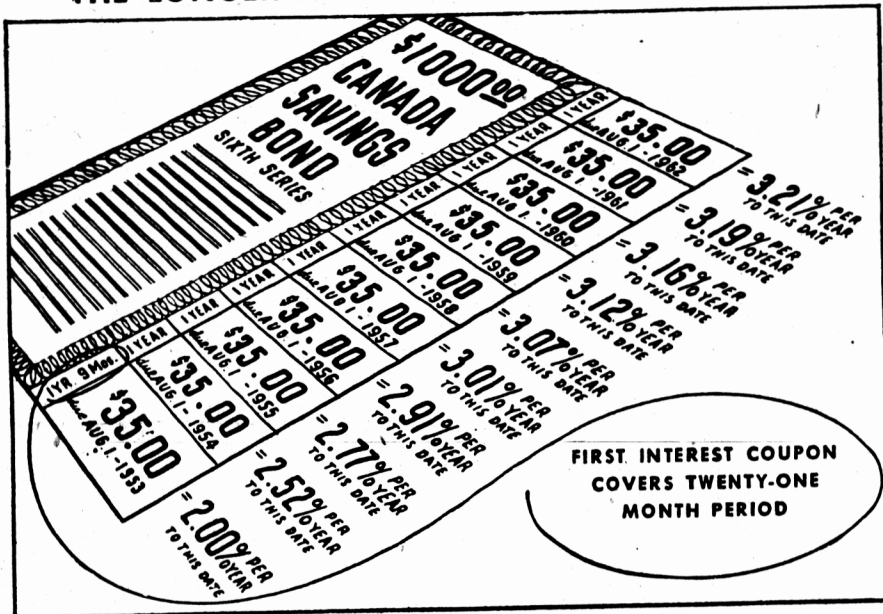

This "rate-per-year" gradually increases as each coupon becomes payable until, for a bond that is held for its full term, the average annual interest rate reaches 3.21%.

CANADA SAVINGS BONDS are registered in the owner's name. They are non-assignable and non-transferable.

Holdings in any one name limited to \$5,000. Each member of a family may hold up to this amount. (Previous limit was \$1,000.)
