MARGARET (MULLEN) GRIFFIN BURSARY

The annual \$500 bursary entitled the "MARGARET (MULLEN) GRIFFIN BURSARY" is to be awarded to any Island single parent (male or female) who is a full-time student taking at least three courses per semester in the School of Nursing at the University of Prince Edward Island.

It shall be awarded by application to the Scholarship and Awards Committee on the basis of financial need after the first year of study. Applicants must have maintained an average of 65% in their nursing courses in the first year of study.

NOTE: For the purposes of this bursary, Island residency is defined as having spent a significant portion of one's life in this province.

Application forms are available at the Registrar's Office or at the School of Nursing.

Deadline for applications is mid-October.

Rotary Club Bursary

The Rotary Club of Charlottetown Bursary shall be awarded to international students enrolled in full-time studies at the University of Prince Edward Island.

Academic achievement and financial need will be the selection criteria; therefore, students from developing countries will be of particular interest.

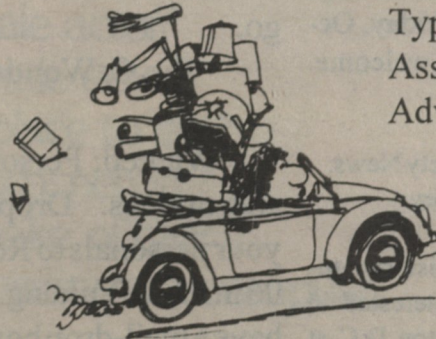
Student Union jobs provide valuable experience, are conveniently located on campus and provide an opportunity to become more involved at UPEI.
