To submit a nomination, write a letter explaining why the nominee should receive this award, and drop it off at the Barn by the deadline.

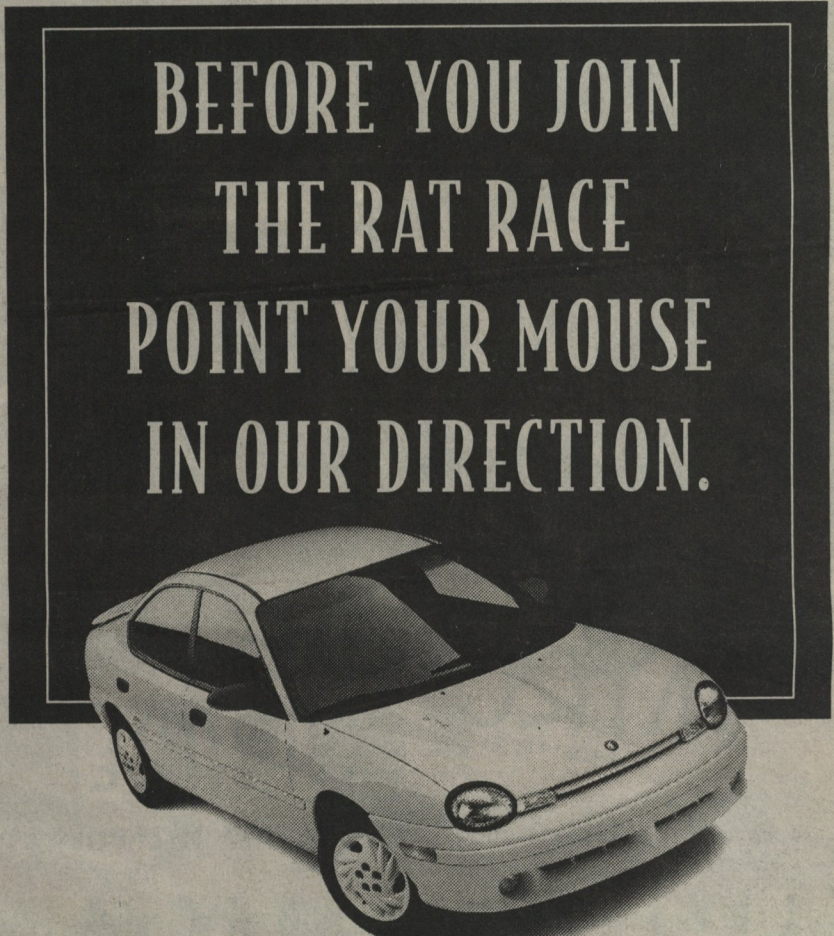
## New Student Orientation
