Montgomery Wants New Defence Plan Immediately

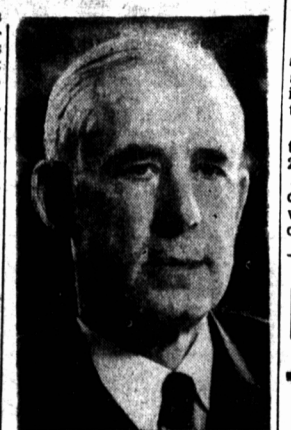

2 Mad Brothers Captured

The brothers, setting a price of 200,000,000 lire (\$380,000) for the release of the children, shouted fantastic demands from the windows.
