How can the government allow multiple housing structures directly across the street from UPEI. Just wait till they build enough apartments over there and we'll have no one in the dorms at all.

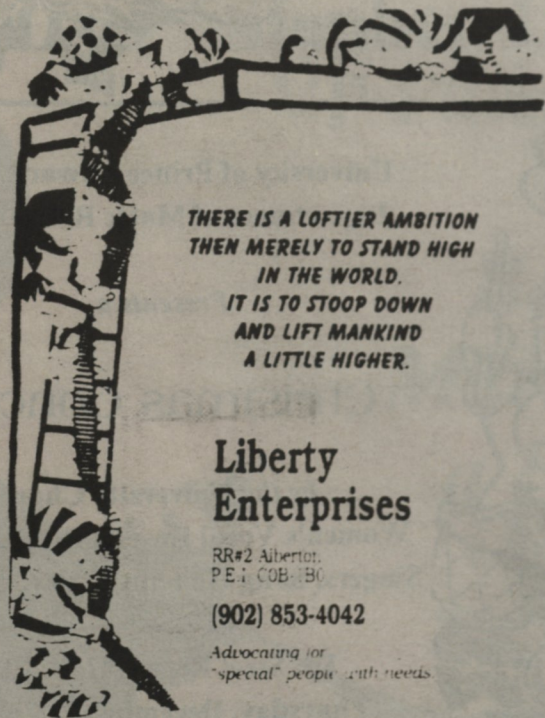

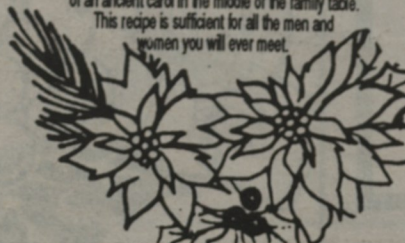
