Bank of Commerce trading ex-dividend led a drop in banks, down 1/4 to 62 1/2. Imperial lost 1/4 to 7 1/2 and Royal Bank was down 1/4 to 94 1/2.
Oils gained, led by B-A up 1/2 to 37. Imperial Oil gained 1/4 to 40 1/2 and Texaco Canada rose one to 74.
In mixed paper group International Paper gained 5 points at 113. Fraser, trading ex-dividend, lost 1/4 to 31.
In a lower food group Dominion fell 1/2 to a new low of 66 1/2. Seiberg's A lost 1 to 31 1/2 and Loblaw's B hit a new low at 31 1/2, down 1/4.
Beverages were strong with Molson's B up 1/4 to 29 and Molson's A up one to 29. Labatts gained 1/4 to 28 1/2.
Miscellaneous issues were generally lower with General Dynamics off one to 52 and Industrial Acceptance down 1/2 to 37. Canadian Fairbanks Morse rose one to 33.
Speculative issues were mixed Central Del Rio gained 25 cents at 6.55 and St. Lawrence River gained 20 cents at 4.40.
