

# Low-Level Jet Takes Heavy Toll Of Life

 OTTAWA (CP) — The daredevil business of flying a super-scale jet plane at low level—some 50 feet above the ground—is beginning to exact its human toll.  
 "You cannot fly an aircraft without having casualties," said former defence minister George Pearkes, VC, soon after the government announced in the summer of 1959 it was buying the supersonic CF-104 low-level jet bomber for the RCAF as a division in Europe.  
 An RCAF spokesman said killed flying the CF-104 and eight of the planes have been destroyed.

000 flying hours compared to a rate of 3.2 throughout the air force. The F-104 rate dropped to 39.8 in 1960, still the highest for any operational plane in the U.S. Air Force.  
 The RCAF spokesman said Wednesday the accident rate for the CF-104—and all other RCAF planes—is secret.  
 The spokesman added that there has been no difficulty finding CF-104 pilots. The opposite was the case: There were many more pilots who wanted to fly the plane than could be used in the eight CF-104 squadrons.  
 Three pilots have been killed at the training base at Cold Lake, Alta., one at Zweibrücken, West Germany, and one at the NATO bombing range in Southern Sardinia.  
 Probably the most terrible accident was one at Cold Lake in which the pilot managed to eject safely. However, the wind carried his parachute over the burning wreckage of the CF-104 and he dropped into the fire.

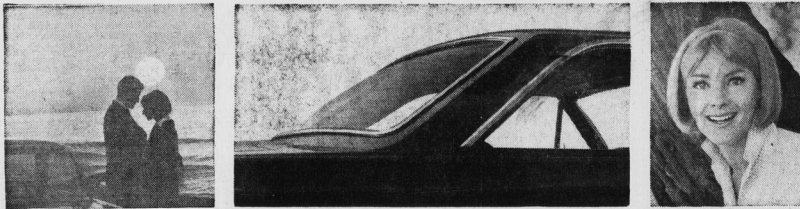
## Conservative MP Calls For Judy To Quit

OTTAWA (CP) — Conservative MP Louis-Joseph Pigeon has called for the resignation of her as 14th Minister LaMarsh because of statements attributed to her in a Toronto newspaper.  
 Earlier, Miss LaMarsh had denied making the statement.  
 Mr. Pigeon rejected her denial, despite the insistence of Liberal benches that under Commons rules Miss LaMarsh's denial must be accepted.  
 Mr. Pigeon, member for Joliette - L'Assomption-Montcalm, said he has more faith in the statements of newspaper men than in the statements of Miss LaMarsh.  
 The disputed report, in The Globe and Mail of Sept. 27, quoted Miss LaMarsh as having said the large pension fund planned by the Quebec government might lead to a form of

national socialism like Nazi Germany's.  
 Asked about the report during the day's question period, Miss LaMarsh said the question gave her the opportunity "to deny that I have made such a statement at any time to anyone."  
 Mr. Pigeon raised the issue during later debate on the government proposal for a \$10 increase in old age pensions.  
 Miss LaMarsh quickly interrupted him to repeat her denial, and when he persisted, State Secretary Pickersgill said the minister's denial must be accepted under Commons rules.  
 Following the supper adjournment, Mr. Pigeon returned to the issue. Miss LaMarsh was out of the chamber and returned just at the end of his speech, to which she made no immediate reply.
