**Steel Prices  
 May Be Hiked  
 By New Tax**

HAMILTON (CP) — Stability of steel prices which has prevailed in Canada since 1957 may be joggled if the 11 per cent sales tax is kept on production and maintenance materials and parts.

"It is difficult to forecast how we will be able to maintain existing prices," Frank H. Sherman, president of Dominion Foundries and Steel Ltd., told shareholders in a mid-year report.

Mr. Sherman referred to the fact there has been no increases in selling prices of the rolled steel over the last six years.

He listed these additional cost factors which Dofasco has to meet:

Eight per cent added to the cost of iron ore and coal by the premium on the United States dollar.

Eleven per cent sales tax levied by the federal government on production and maintenance materials and parts.

Annual wage increases since 1957, with a further increase effective in August.

Dofasco's production, sales and operating profits for the first six months of 1963 were the highest in its history, approximately 10 per cent ahead of the same period last year.

"Present indications are for a capacity operation throughout the third quarter and we fully expect to finish with another record year," he said.

**Sarah Churchill's  
 Third Husband  
 Dies Suddenly**

GRANADA, Spain (Reuters)—Lord Audley, 49-year-old third husband of Sir Winston Churchill's daughter Sarah, collapsed and died following a heart attack at his hotel here early today.

A British embassy spokesman in Madrid confirmed the death of Audley, who married Miss Churchill last year.

Miss Churchill was Lord Audley's second wife. His previous marriage was dissolved.

Audley was taken ill shortly after 5 a.m. following a visit to a Granada night club with his wife.

Audley, an artist, once ran a London glass firm producing some of the world's finest engraved glassware. He supported Churchill with special brandy glasses.

The couple met in Spain in 1962 and were married soon after.

Last April, Miss Churchill returned to the London stage after a two year absence to star in a play written by her husband. From this Hill. The play was poorly received by the critics and had only a short run.

Audley, who was the 23rd baron, was educated at Lancing College and Hertford College, Oxford, and served in the Worcestershire Regiment.

Audley was Miss Churchill's third husband.

Her first marriage to comedian Vic Oliver was dissolved in 1945. Her second husband, society photographer Anthony Beauchamp, committed suicide in 1957.

**102 Fires  
 Burn In Ont.**

TORONTO (CP) — Reinforcements were moved into the northern White River area and firefighters were patrolling or fighting another 102 fires across Ontario Wednesday.

In the White River area, near Wawa, the situation was described as critical as nearly 500 men, four planes and two helicopters struggled to prevent a raging 1,000-acre forest fire from spreading.

Department of lands and forests officers advised bush area settlers to move to towns in case the blaze gets out of hand.

Men were being recruited near Sault Ste. Marie, Ont. Wednesday to combat another fire burning out of control north of the Blind River. All woods travel permits in the area were cancelled.

In Toronto, department officials said the number of fires was the highest reported in one day in the history of its records which stretch back seven years.

He said more than 2,000 men, 43 department Beaver and Otter aircraft, 12 to 15 commercial aircraft and 12 helicopters are fighting the fires. If necessary, the department could mobilize between 4,000 and 10,000 men, he said. The most ever mobilized was 5,000 in 1955.

**Gov't Withholds  
 Security Costs**

OTTAWA (CP) — The government refused Wednesday to say what it spends on security.

"It is not considered in the public interest" to publish the figures, the government said in a written reply in the Commons to Douglas Fisher (NDP—Port Arthur).

Mr. Fisher had asked for the figures for the last three fiscal years and an estimate for this year. He also wanted comparisons with American and British security expenditures.

Britain and the U.S. do not publish such figures, the government noted.
