Service Awards Given Auxiliary

At the Charlottetown Hotel on Wednesday, a special luncheon of the Charlottetown Women's Auxiliary of the Canadian National Institute for the Blind was held in honor of six of their members who were presented with "Twenty-five Year Service Awards" commemorating voluntary service to the blind people of this province and in prevention of blindness.

Mrs. I.B. Murphy, president, presided. At the head table were the honored members along with guests, including: Mrs. W.J. MacDonald, wife of the Lt. Governor; B.W. Patterson, chairman of the P.E.I. Advisory Board to the CNIB; F.H. Flinn, superintendent of the Maritime Division of the CNIB; and P.C. Bower, field secretary for the province.

Mr. Flinn addressed the meeting and gave a resume of the

organization and activities carried out by the Auxiliary, after which he presented the awards. The recipients of this honor were: Mrs. M.A. Farmer; Mrs. J.D. MacGuigan; Mrs. W.J.P. MacMillan; Mrs. H.F. MacPhee; Mrs. J.J. Morris; and Mrs. T.W.L. Prowse. Mrs. Morris and Mrs. Prowse were unable to be present due to illness, and their awards were presented to them at their homes.

Mrs. Mrs. W.J.P. MacMillan, Mrs. H.F. MacPhee, and Mrs. T.W.L. Prowse are chartered members of the Auxiliary, which was formed on Nov. 16, 1937. Mr. Patterson, on behalf of the P.E.I. Advisory Board, congratulated the ladies receiving awards, and pointed out that the Auxiliary has played a vital role in extending CNIB services to the blind of this area.

Former Mt. A. Rugby Star Is Safety Meeting Speaker

At the Charlottetown Hotel on Monday, the 4th annual Industrial Safety Conference sponsored by the Workmen's Compensation Board of Prince Edward Island will be held. The chairman will be J. Wilfred MacAleer, chairman of the Workmen's Compensation Board of P.E.I.

Keynote address in the one-day meeting will be delivered by R.F. Titus, president Standard Paving Maritime Ltd., and well known former rugby star of Mount Allison University.

Mr. Titus joined Standard Paving (Maritime) Limited, Halifax, as construction engineer in 1950. He served in various capacities until his present appointment this year.

The morning session will also include a film, a talk on the role and services of the Workmen's Compensation Board in industrial safety, and a question and answer period.

An important part of the program will be a display of safety equipment.

One of the highlights of the afternoon session will be a panel discussion with W.L. Grandmire, executive director of New Brunswick Industrial Safety Council as moderator. Other members of the panel will be M.E. Kingston, plant superintendent of New Brunswick International Paper Co., W. Urquhart, chief boiler inspector, province of Nova Scotia, and R.F. Titus.

A second panel consisting of Evelyn Cudmore, moderator, Sinclair Cutcliffe, Ed Chimney, Norman McLeod and Bruce McLaren will discuss industrial first aid.

Robert Kerr, provincial fire marshal's department, Halifax,

will talk on fire hazard and give a demonstration.

At a dinner in the evening the guest speaker will be R.E. Anderson, Nova Scotia deputy minister of labor.

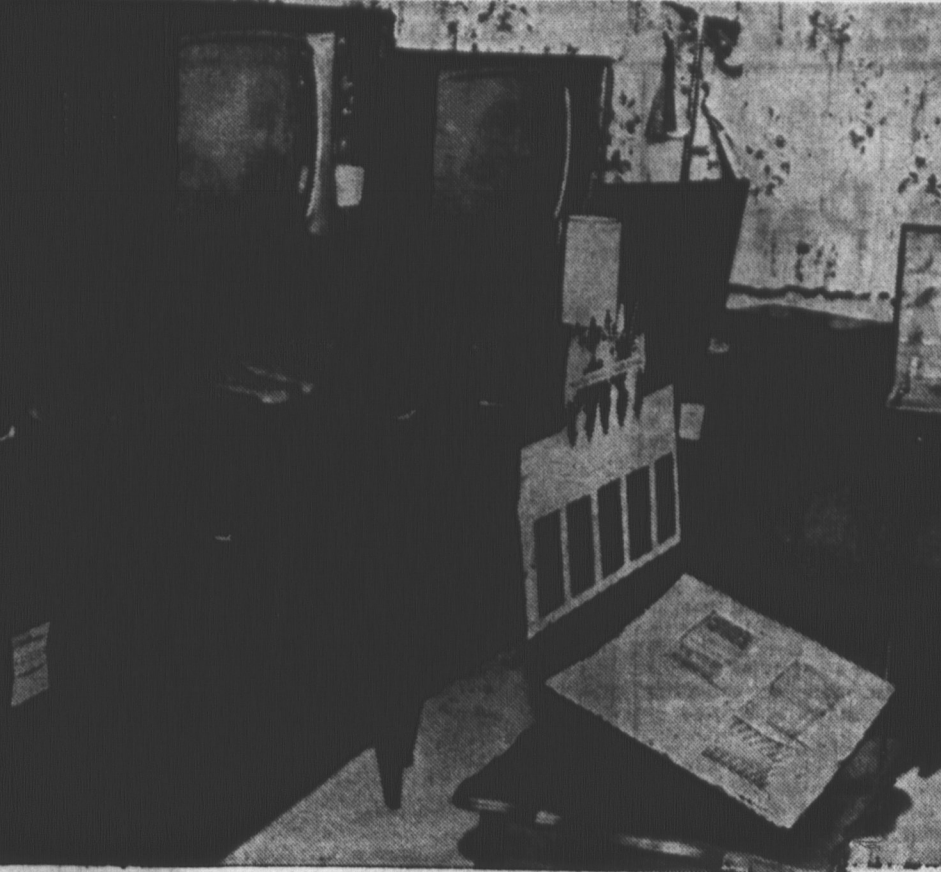

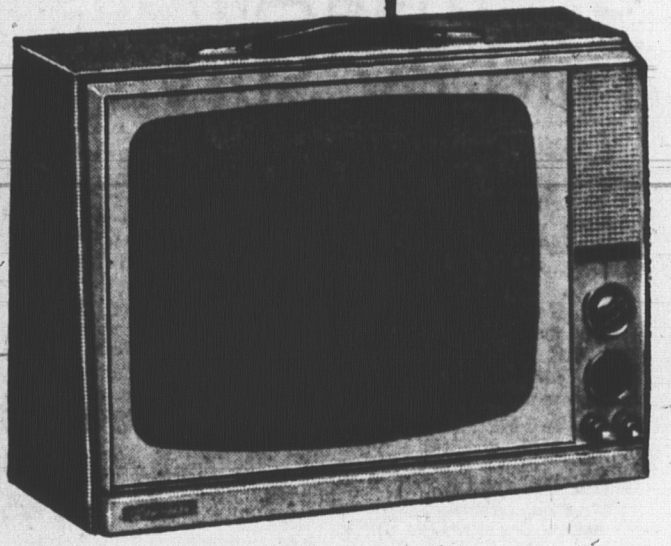
