Alberta After The Grasshoppers

CALGARY, May 16—Unless the farmers of southern Alberta adopt an active campaign against the grasshoppers there will be no crops this year in any part of the province, according to a statement made today by Mr. E. H. Strickland, professor of entomology, in the University of Alberta, who has charge of combating the menace in Alberta. Last year, Mr. Strickland said 2,000 eggs were found to a square foot of ground, this year unless preventative measures are adopted the number will be at least 5,000.


