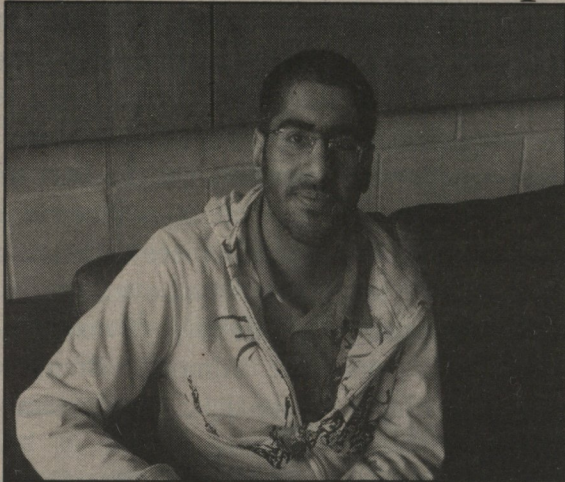
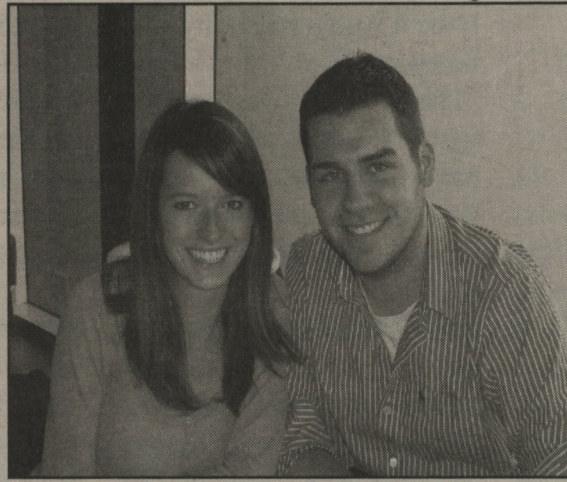


The Cadre asks:

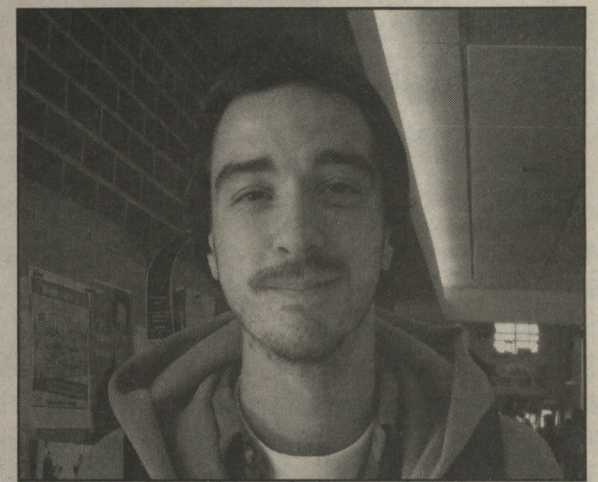
The new fence on Univeristy Avenue is being used to attempt to deter jaywalkers, but at a price of \$190,000. Do you think this is right?



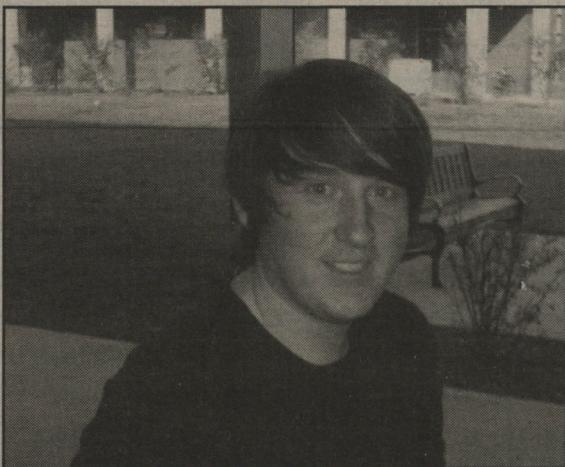
I think it's a good idea because I jaywalk so I think now that I won't be able to, I'll be safe. - **Abdullah Alzuraya, 1st year Engineering**

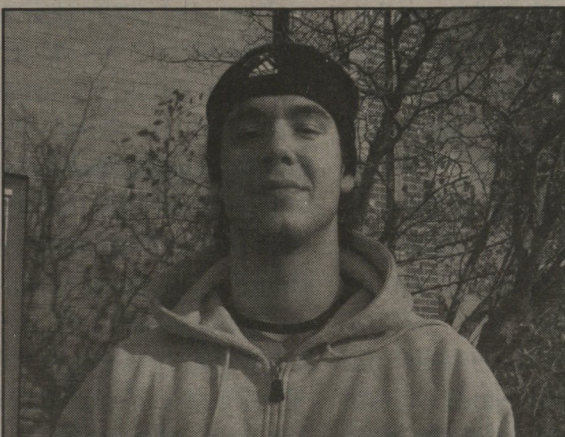
Not sure if it will actually stop people from jaywalking but I think the rod iron looks good. - **James White, 1st year Business**
