Fishermen's Stamp Rules Unchanged

OTTAWA (CP)—It is not practical to revise the unemployment insurance regulation under which a fisherman must appear in person before a buyer in order to qualify for unemployment insurance stamps.

His written reply to Lloyd R. Crouse (P.C.—Queens—Lennoxville) rejected Mr. Crouse's suggestion that this provision be changed.

The minister said that where a fisherman has no actual employer, the buyer of his catch

is responsible for providing the insurance stamp in order to do this properly, the buyer had to know who participated in the catch and ensure that there is no other legal employer involved.
