GREAT MASSACRES RECORDED IN HISTORY.

In B. C. 331 Alexander put 8,000 Tyrians to the sword and crucified 2,000 for not surrendering Tyre.

Marius, the Roman general, slaughtered 200,000 Teutones and Ambrones near Aix in B. C. 102.

Octavianus Caesar ordered the death of 300 Roman senators to the manes of Julius Caesar in B. C. 40.

Jews to the number of 1,100,000 were massacred in the fall of Jerusalem, A. D. 70.

Cassius, the Roman general, put to death 300,000 inhabitants of Selucia in A. D. 165.

The "Sicilian Vespers" massacre in 1266, when over 8,000 French were murdered at Palermo.

St Bartholomew's massacre commenced on the evening of the festival at Paris in 1572. Seventy thousand Huguenots were murdered by secret orders from Charles IX. at the instigation of his mother, Catherine de Medici

Massacre of MacDonalds at Glencoe, Scotland, in 1692, for not surrendering to King William.

Twelve thousand Chinese put to death at Batavia in October, 1740, under pretext of insurrection.

Twenty-four thousand native Christians reported murdered in Cochinchina, and 22,000 in Annam, in 1885.

Native Christians in Armenia, numbering from 30,000 to 40,000, according to various reports, killed by Kurds or Turkish soldiers in 1895.
