

Miss McGarry's Experience.

Miss McGarry, of the Ladies' College, was called upon by a newspaper man while at Quebec, to whom she told the following story of the recent railway accident: "I was a passenger on the Pullman which contained besides myself two young Englishmen, the conductor and porter. I first heard a great rumbling sound, and at the same time I noticed some official running through the car. Then in a moment I felt the car go over, and my only thought was to realize that I was to be instantly killed. It was rather a relief than otherwise, as I did not expect to suffer. It was so instantaneous that I think I must have lost consciousness afterwards. The first thing I knew was when Conductor Mullane asked me if I was hurt. I told him that I did not know, and asked him what had happened. I tried to stand up, but could not as my limbs were very sore from debris falling on me. All the time I remained very quiet and did not utter a cry. I never realized my position until some man standing on our car called out that there were thirty killed. With the aid of the conductor and two other passengers I was lifted out of the car and landed safely on the ground. I was met there by Mr. John McKay of Quebec, who accompanied me to Mr. Young's, where I will remain as a guest until completely recovered. I was imprisoned for about twenty minutes, and during that time Conductor Mullane and the two passengers were exceedingly kind to me, the former particularly. He got some snow and kept it on my face, and no doubt saved my eye, as the snow kept inflammation away. The neighbors also showed great kindness, and offered to do everything for me."

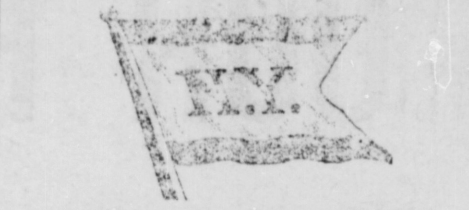

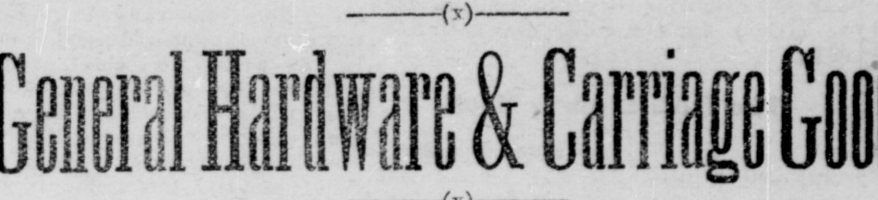
