GRAIN

WINNIPEG, Nov. 3 - (CP) - Most prices displayed a firm tone in active trade today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange. Flax was the only grain to fall lower.

Major factor in the advance was buying prompted by continued drought in the U.S. southwest and reports of dryness across the prairie grain belt. Light offerings also aided the upward trend.

Fairly good buying by shippers appeared in oats, barley. Flax uncovered industrial and seaboard support but all contracts closed lower. Buying was fairly general in rye, where the dryness was a leading factor.

Export loadings of Canadian wheat included 1,700,000 bushels to the United Kingdom, 650,000 to Germany, 370,000 to Israel and 20,000 to Japan.

Prices for class two wheat and I. W. A. were down one-eighth cent from Friday.

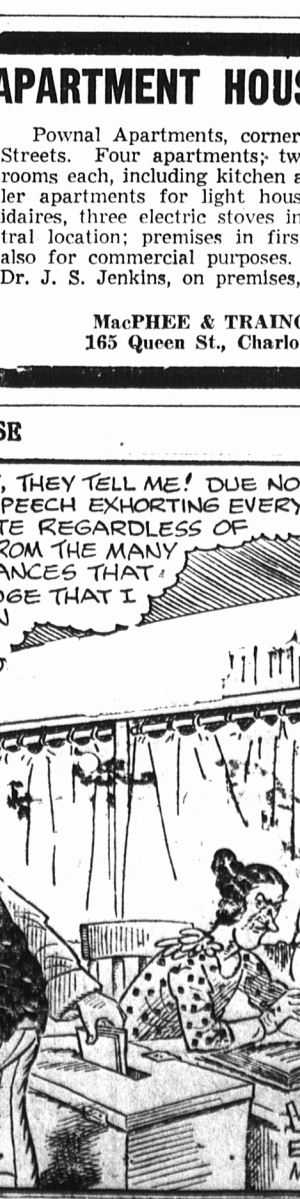
