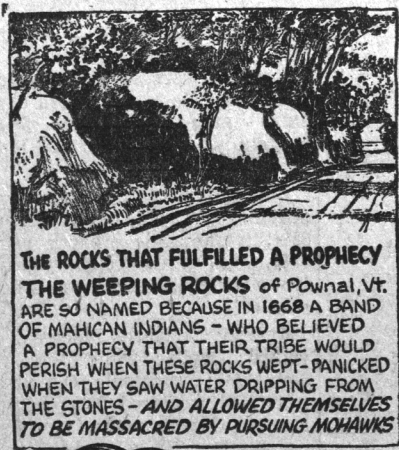
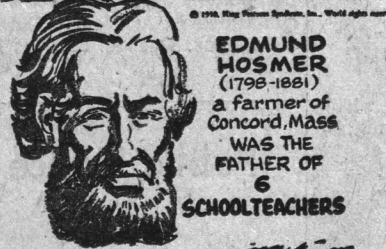

CONTRACT BRIDGE

The bidding:
East South West North
1 4 2 5 Pass 4

Opening lead-six of spades.

How much of bridge is luck, and how much is skill, is a question no one can readily answer. You just can't put all the factors involved on a scale, and weigh them, and come up with a sensible conclusion. Ask the winners in your bridge crowd, and they'll all tell you it's a game of skill. Ask the losers and they'll say it's a luck.

Whichever it may be, consider this hand. South got to five diamonds and West led a spade. East won with the queen and continued with the ace, which South ruffed.

After drawing two rounds of trumps, declarer played a heart

to the ace, and another heart back. When the suit failed to break 2-2, declarer found himself down one.

"Bad luck, you say? No. South could have made the hand. Since the hand was sure to make if the hearts were divided 2-2, all the declarer's efforts should have been devoted to the possibility they were split 3-1. To provide for this distinct possibility, he should have taken measures to prepare for a 3-2 division.

After ruffing the spade, South should lead a trump to dummy, cash the ace of clubs, and ruff a club. He should then enter dummy with a trump and ruff the last club.

Dummy's hand and his own are now out of black cards. A heart is then led and a low heart is played from dummy.

In the actual hand East wins the heart and is forced to lead a black card. South ruffs, discards a heart from dummy, and the contract is made.

The same result is achieved if West's and East's hearts are exchanged. In fact, the contract will always make after the spade is returned, if the hearts are divided 3-1 and the singleton heart is an honor.

Now some people may argue declarer had bad luck not finding the hearts divided 2-2. Others may claim declarer did not exercise the proper amount of skill.

But our position is one of strict neutrality.

Coal Industry Picture Said Not Pretty One

OTTAWA (CP) — The present picture in the coal industry is "not a pretty one," Mines Minister Comtois said Wednesday in the Commons.

The industry's difficulties, he said, will not be solved easily by government action alone, though the government is ready to continue its assistance through subsidies.

Mr. Comtois, speaking during a study of his departmental estimates, said federal coal subsidies are not designed to make that fuel cheaper than gas or oil, but to make it competitive.

Maximum subsidies now amount to \$5.25 a ton for Nova Scotia coal and \$4 a ton for Western coal, plus a duty on imports of 50 cents a ton.

Armand Dumas (L - Ville-neuve) said he hopes that if ever the government sets up a national energy board—as advocated by the Liberal opposition—it will make sure that the Dominion C. board will remain separate.

H. J. Robichaud (L - Gloucester) asked whether Mr. Comtois believes there should be a limit to the amount of government assistance on coal.
