Nova Scotia has had a flag for more than three centuries...

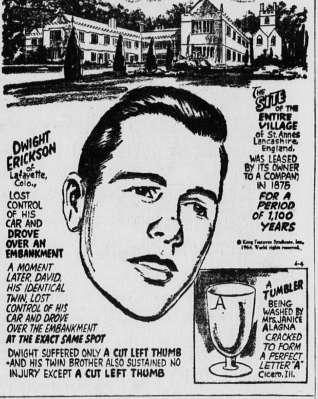
Prince Edward Island celebrating the 100th anniversary of the Charlottetown Confederation conference, picked a flag for itself this spring without public notice...
