Haridas Mundhra, one of India's biggest financiers, was sentenced Monday to jail terms totalling 16 years on fraud charges. Mundhra was sentenced to two terms of six years rigorous imprisonment, one of four years and a fine of 200,000 rupees (\$42,000) on charges of having cheated the British India Corporation and of having used forged documents as genuine.
