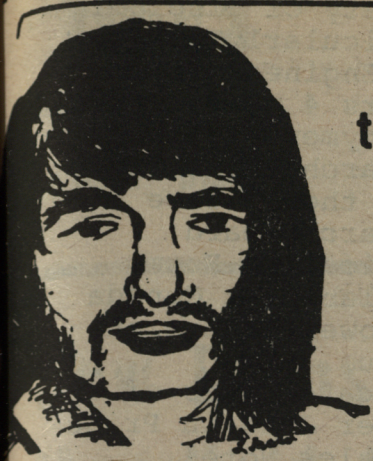


How to Succeed in College Without Really Paying
